.gwallet.com	ra1_uid, ra1_pd_	These cookies are used to show you advertising messages that are more relevant to you. They perform functions like preventing the same ad from continuously reappearing, ensuring that ads are properly displayed for advertisers, and selecting advertisements that are based on your interests.
